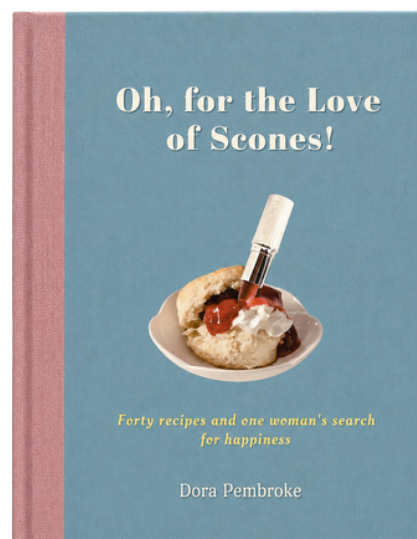


oh, for the Love of Scones!

Oh, for the Love of Scones! is a narrative cookbook that uses recipes as a framework for storytelling. The book pairs food with moments from a woman's life, from romantic expectation to domestic reality.

Written with dry humour and affectionate irreverence, the book explores the belief that happiness will arrive fully formed. Instead, it explores the idea that joy, frustration, longing, often coexist at the same kitchen bench. The recipes are practical and cookable; the story is comical, and occasionally inappropriate.
