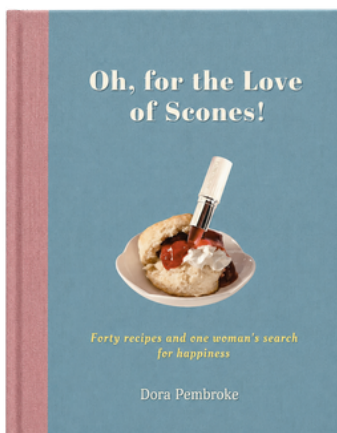
Dora Pembroke writes about food, reinvention, and the promises women inherit. She likes to use humour and metaphor as a way into larger conversations about meaning.

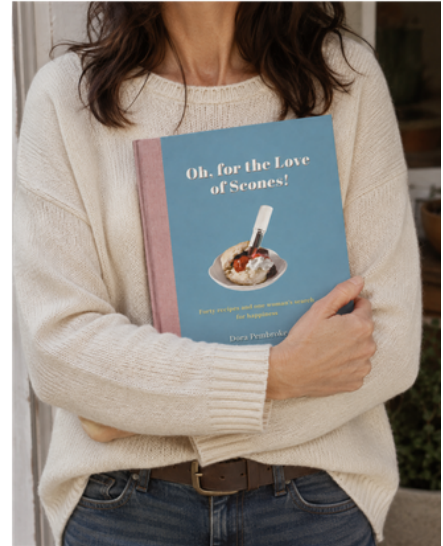
